 Murcia, 22nd of November 2004**

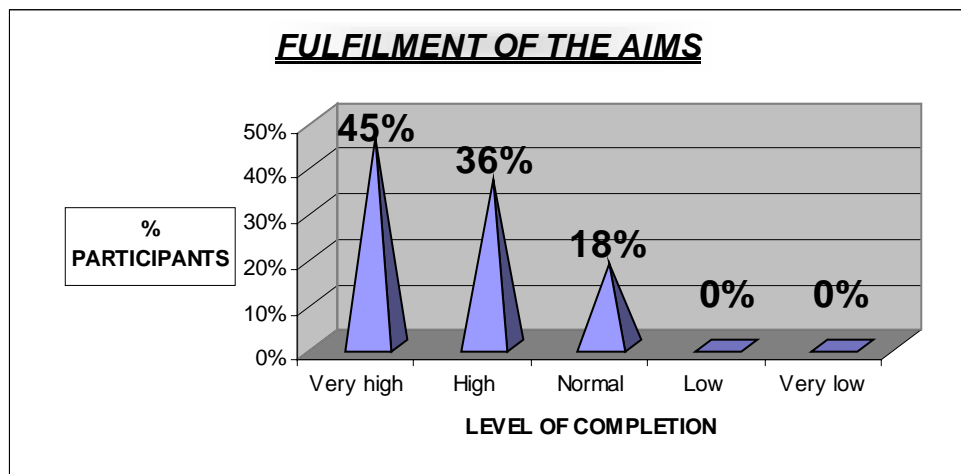

The conclusions resulting from those quetionnaires belong to the representatives from the following European countries:

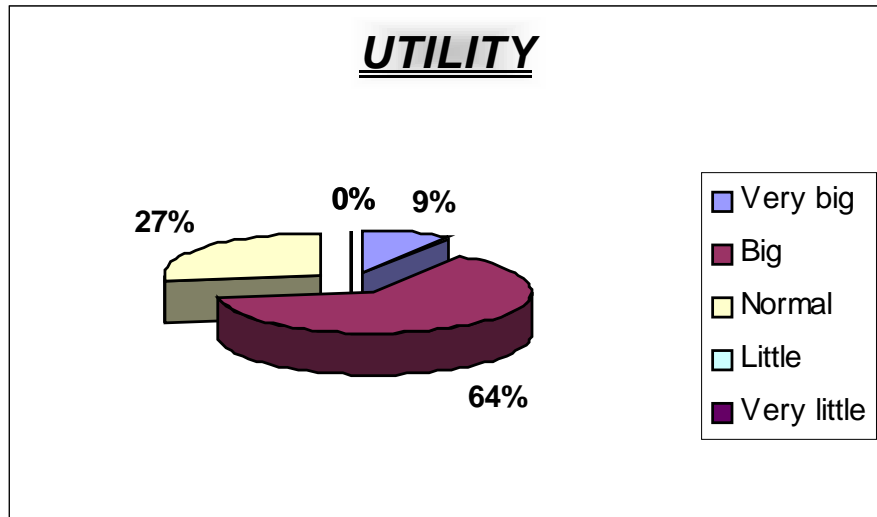
- ✓ Spain, Belgium, Portugal and United Kingdom.

At the end of the Seminar, every attendant received an evaluation questionnaire to asses the level of satisfaction with his/her participation, considering different aspects.

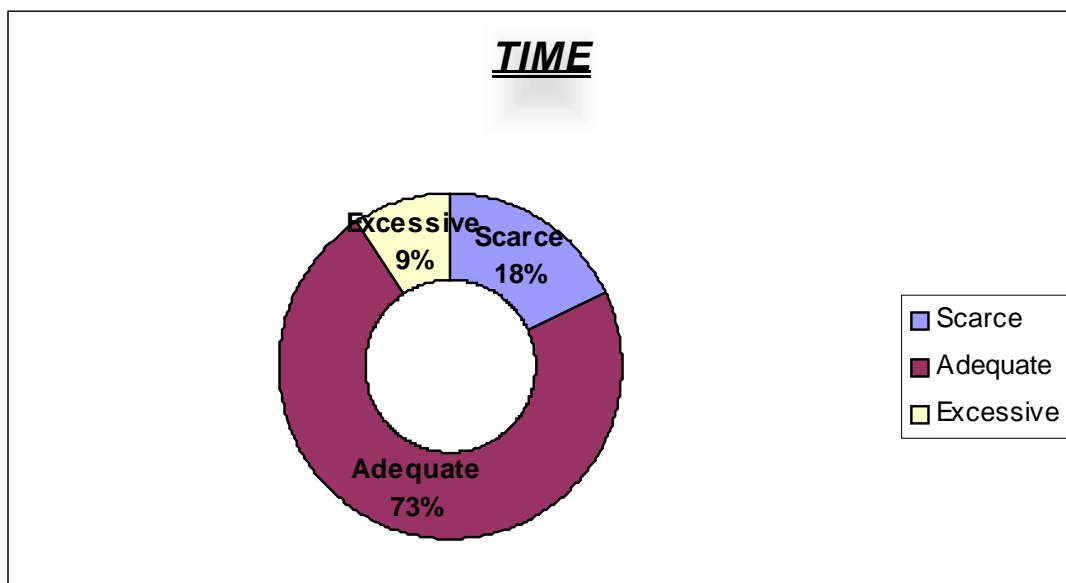
These are the conclusions resulting from those questionnaires:



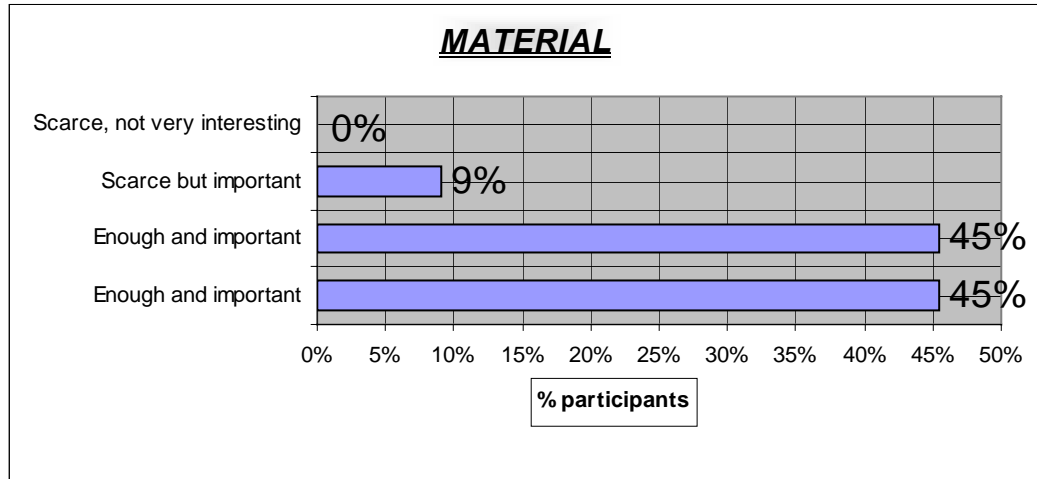
Regarding the level of completion of the programme, all the attendants considered that it was fulfilled; 81% of the participants to the meeting have evaluated it as either "High" or "Very High", 18% considered it as "Normal". It is important that nobody evaluated it as "Low" or "Very low".



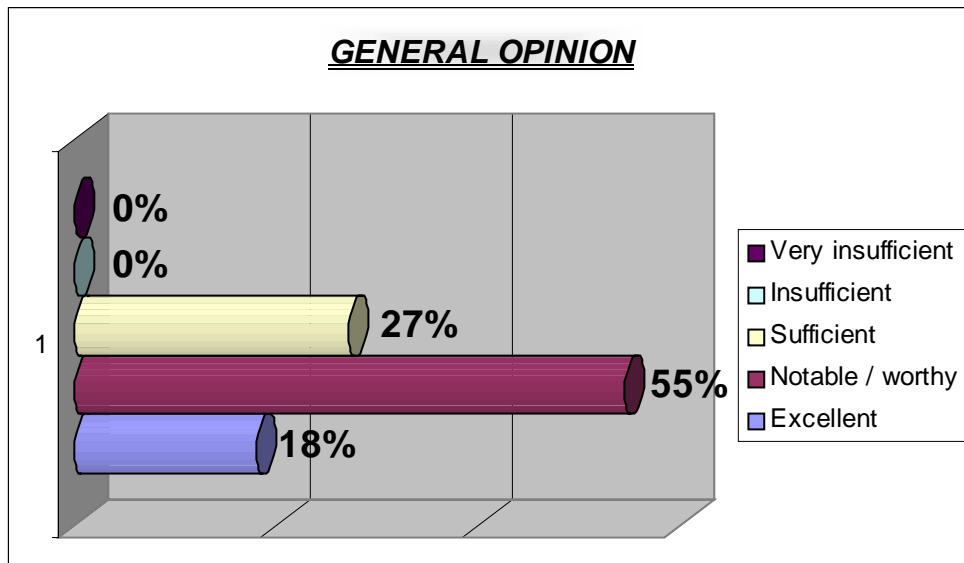
All the persons who were present felt satisfied due to their attendance to the meeting. 73% of them thought that their own satisfaction with the participation in the meeting was "Big" or "Very Big", the rest of the persons evaluated it as "Normal".



73% of the participants, considered that the time dedicated to the meeting was "Adequate". 18% of the whole attendants thought that it would have been good to have more time. The opinion of the rest of the people was that the time dedicated was excessive.



Regarding the material provided at the beginning of the meeting, 90% of the attendants thought that it was “Enough and important” or “Enough”. 9% considered it as important, although they would have liked to receive more materials.



As a whole, 73% of the participants held the meeting in high esteem, so they evaluated it either as “Excellent” (18%) or as “Notable” (55%). 27% considered it was “Sufficient” and nobody thought it was insufficient.
