

EVALUATION OF THE FIRST EUROPEAN PARTNERS' MEETING E-CONS
Santiago de Compostela, 1-3 June 2006

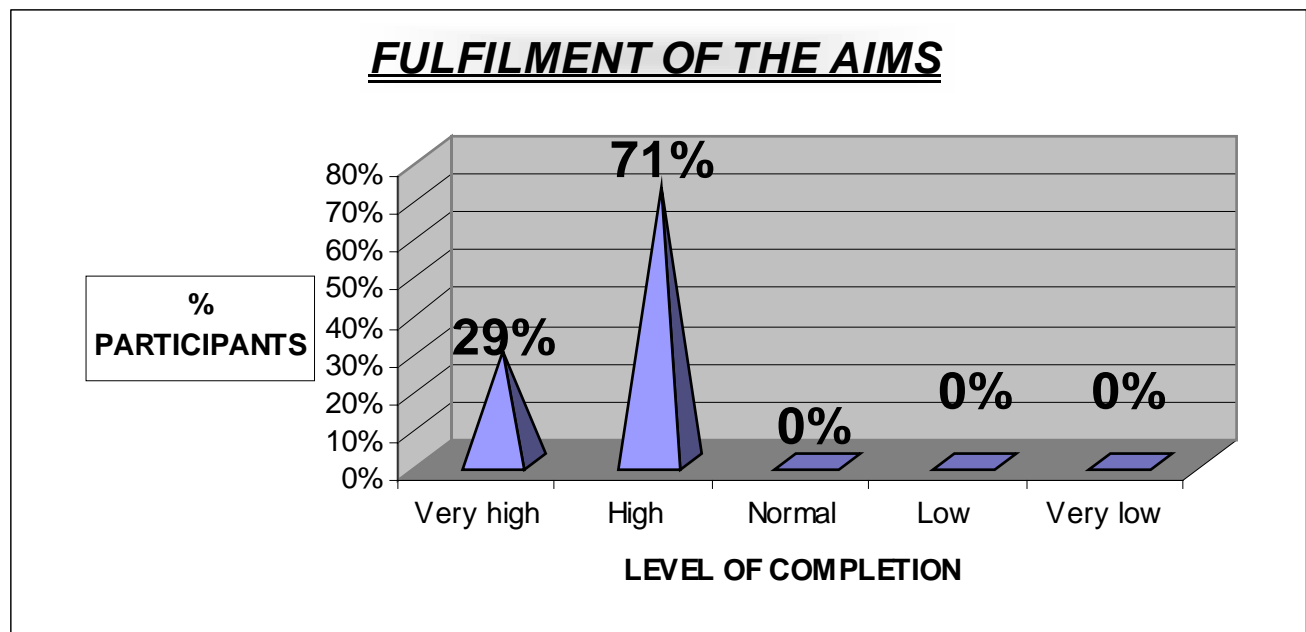
From the 1st to the 3rd of June 2006, the first European Partners' Meeting of the E-CONS Network took place in Santiago de Compostela (Spain). The main aim of this questionnaire is to assess how this activity works and to give alternatives to the questions handled.

The conclusions resulting from those questionnaires belong to the representatives from the following European countries:

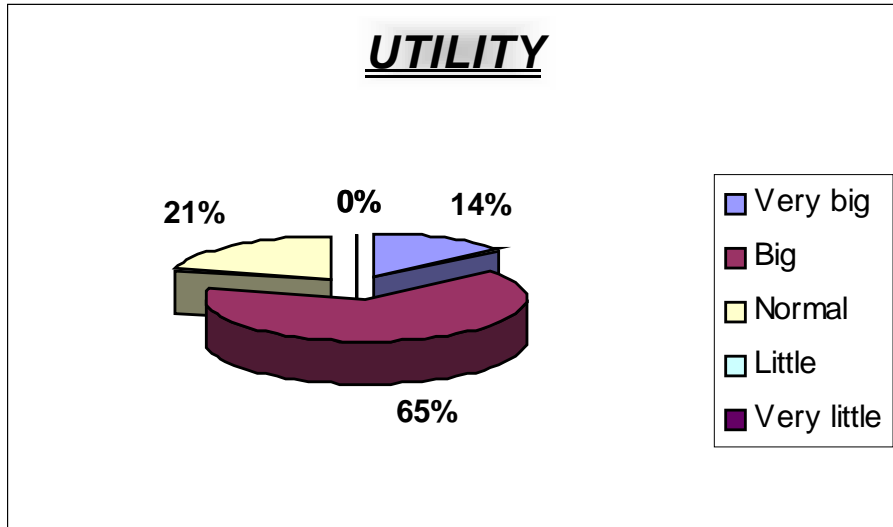
- ✓ Spain, Bulgaria, Latvia, Poland, Slovakia, Luxembourg, France, Portugal, Lithuania and United Kingdom.

At the end of the meeting, every attendant received an evaluation questionnaire to assess the level of satisfaction with his/her participation, considering different aspects.

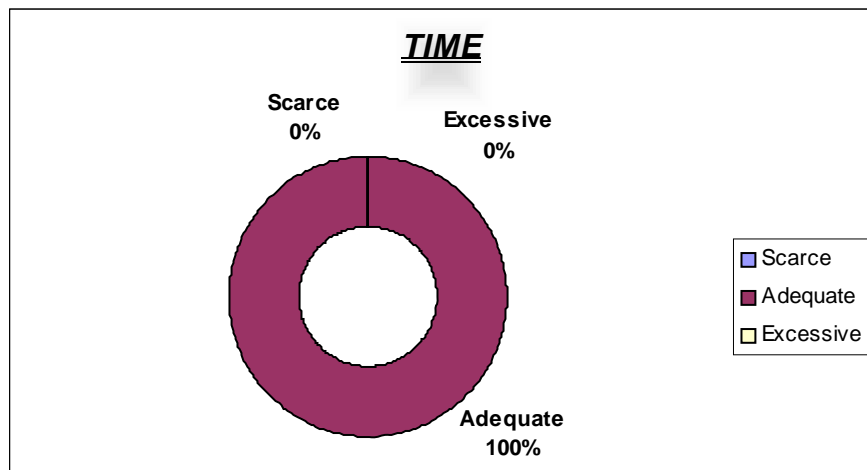
These are the conclusions resulting from those questionnaires:



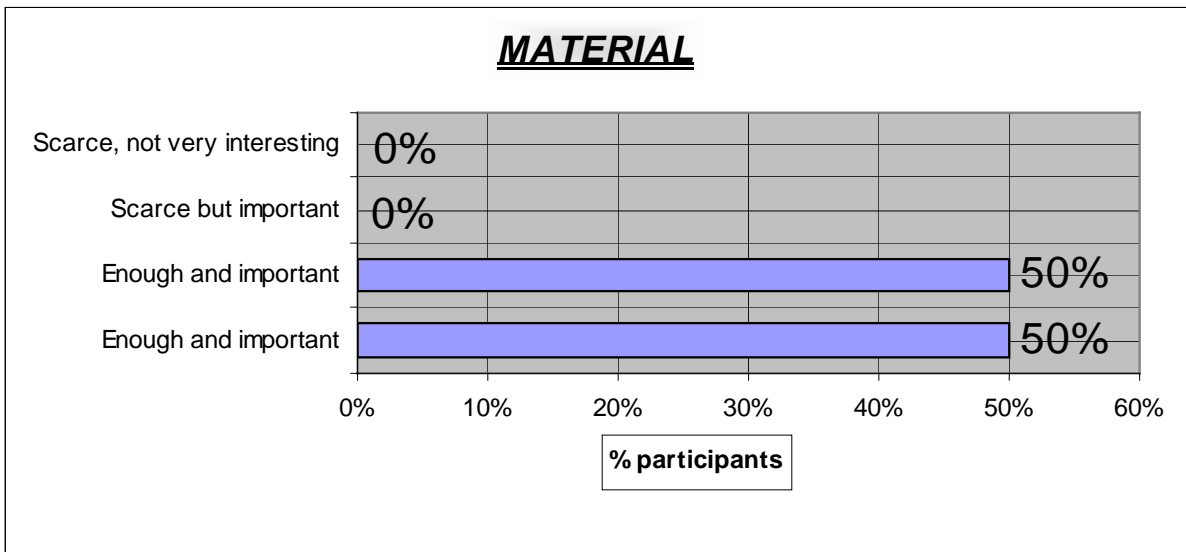
Regarding the level of completion of the programme, all the attendants considered that it was fulfilled; 100% of the participants to the meeting have evaluated it as either "High" or "Very High". It is important that nobody evaluated it as "Low" or even "Very low".



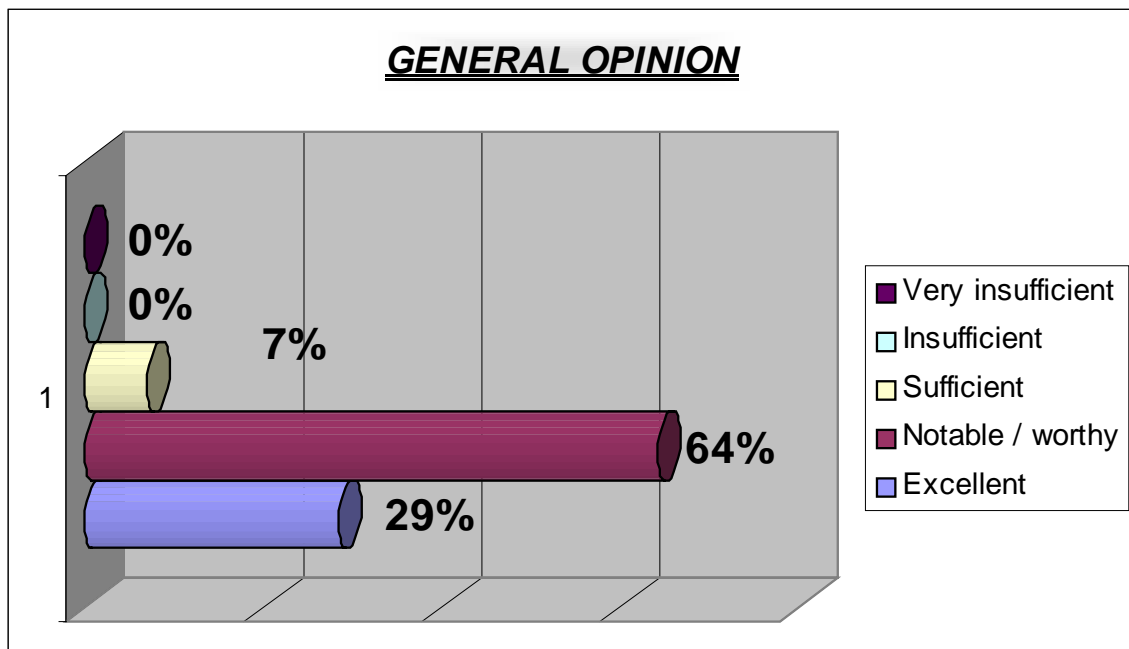
All the persons who were present felt satisfied due to their attendance to the meeting. 86% of them thought that their own satisfaction with the participation in the meeting was "Big" or "Very Big", the rest of the persons evaluated it as "Normal".



100% of the participants considered that the time dedicated to the meeting was "Adequate".



Regarding the material provided at the beginning of the meeting, 100% of the attendants thought that it was "Enough and important" or "Enough".



As a whole, 93% of the participants held the meeting in high esteem, so they evaluated it either as "Excellent" (29%) or as "Notable" (64%). 7% considered it was "Sufficient" and nobody thought it was insufficient.
