EVALUATION OF THE TRAINERS TRAINING MEETING OF THE E-CONS NETWORK

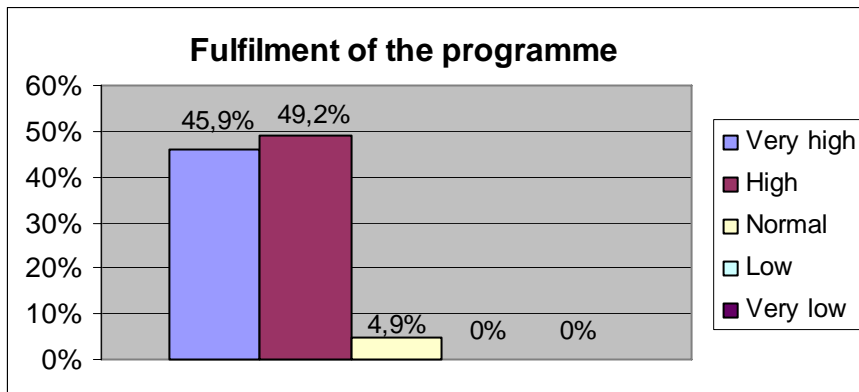
On 26th, 27th and 28th March 2009, the E-CONS NETWORK (Comenius 3) has organized in Valencia (Spain), with the collaboration of the Generalitat Valenciana (Department of Industry, Trade and Innovation, Directorate-General Trade and Consumer Affairs), the Trainers Training Meeting of the E-CONS NETWORK within the frame of the project ENFORMA EC (Comenius Accompanying Measures of the Lifelong Learning Programme of the European Union).

130 persons of the field of consumer affairs (consumer associations, teachers, public and private organizations) from the following European countries have participated in this Meeting:

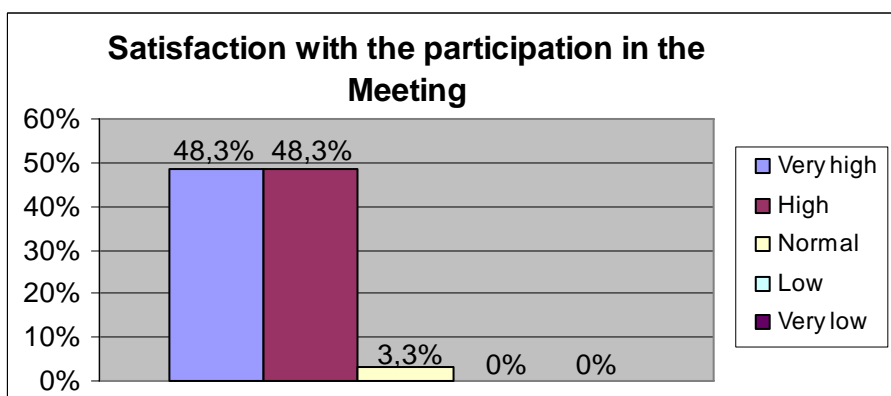
- Spain: the following Autonomous Communities have participated: Aragón, Canarias, Cantabria, Castilla-La Mancha, Cataluña, Extremadura, Galicia, Comunidad de Madrid, Región de Murcia, Comunidad Foral de Navarra, La Rioja, Comunidad Valenciana, País Vasco and the Autonomous City of Melilla.
- European countries which have participated: Belgium, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Denmark, France, Germany, Greece, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Poland, Romania and Slovakia.

At the end of the Meeting, each participant received an evaluation questionnaire to assess the level of satisfaction regarding various aspects.

The results of these questionnaires are as follows:

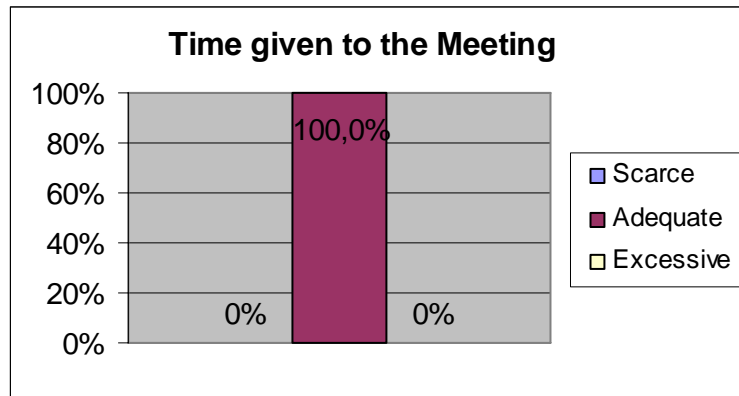


With respect to the level of fulfilment of the programme, all participants think that the programme has been fulfilled; 95,1% of the participants have evaluated it as "High" or "Very high" and 4,9% as "Normal". Nobody has evaluated it as "Low" or "Very low".

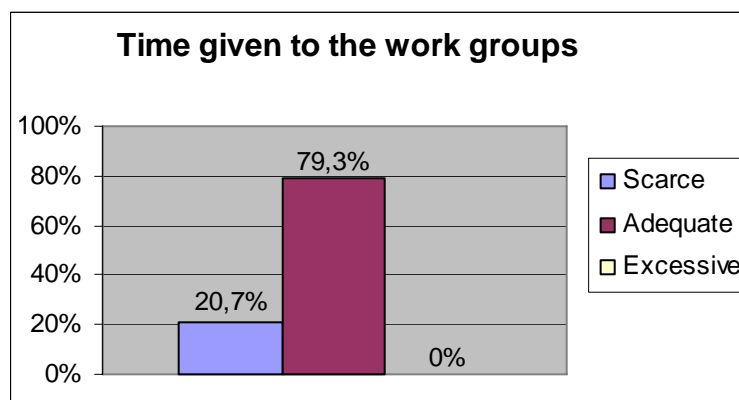


Most participants have been satisfied with their assistance at the Meeting because they could exchange experiences, get to know new projects and works, find partners for their own projects, see elaborated materials and obtain ideas for themselves and future activities.

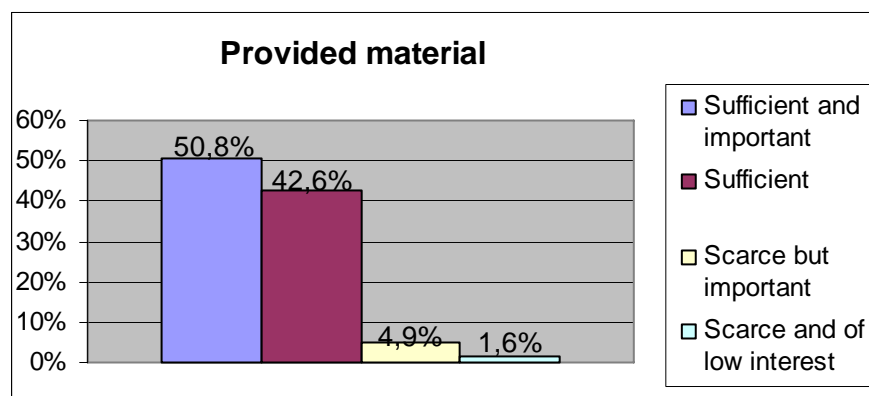
96,6% of the participants say that their satisfaction with the participation in the Meeting has been "High" or "Very high". 3,3% think it has been "Normal".



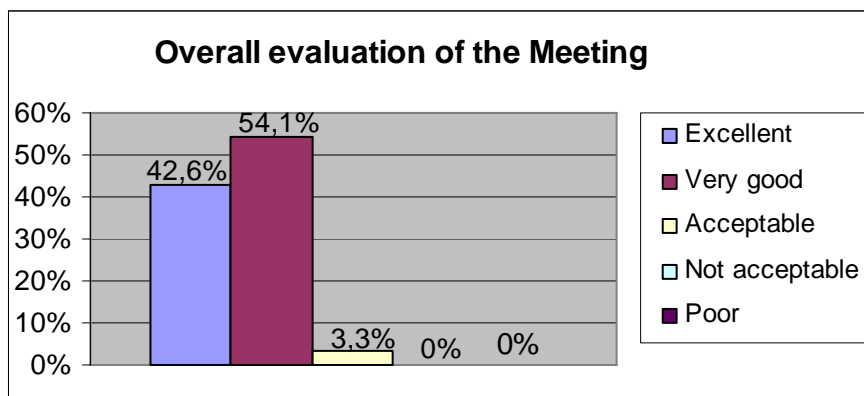
100% of the participants think that the time given to the Meeting was adequate.



79,3% of the participants think that the time given to the work groups was adequate. 20,7% say it would have been better to have more time to meet more people and exchange knowledge and experiences.



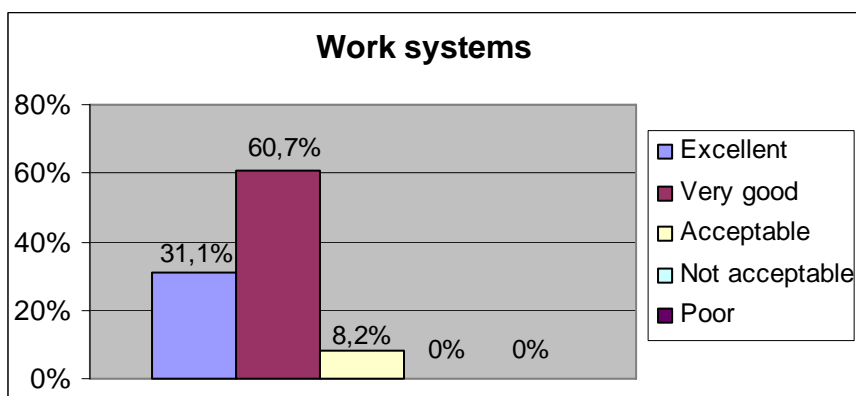
93,4% of the participants believe that the material provided at the beginning of the Meeting has been "Sufficient and important" or "Sufficient". 4,9% think that it has been important but they had prefer to get more material and 1,6% think that the provided material has not been sufficient and of low interest.



In general aspects, 96,7% of the participants evaluate the Meeting as “Excellent” (42,6%) and “Very good” (54,1%). 3,3% evaluate the Meeting as “Acceptable”.

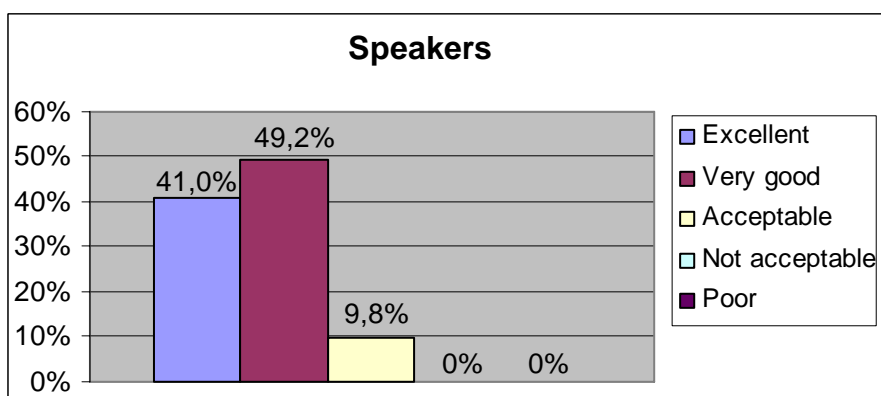
How do you evaluate the following aspects of the Meeting?

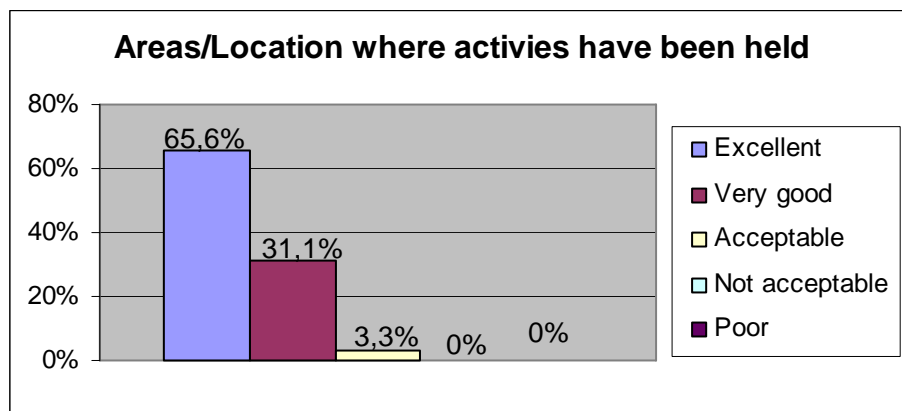
As to the work systems during the Meeting consisting of speeches and work groups, all the participants think it was adequate. 31,1% evaluate it with “Excellent”, 60,7% with “Very good” and 8,2% with “Acceptable”.

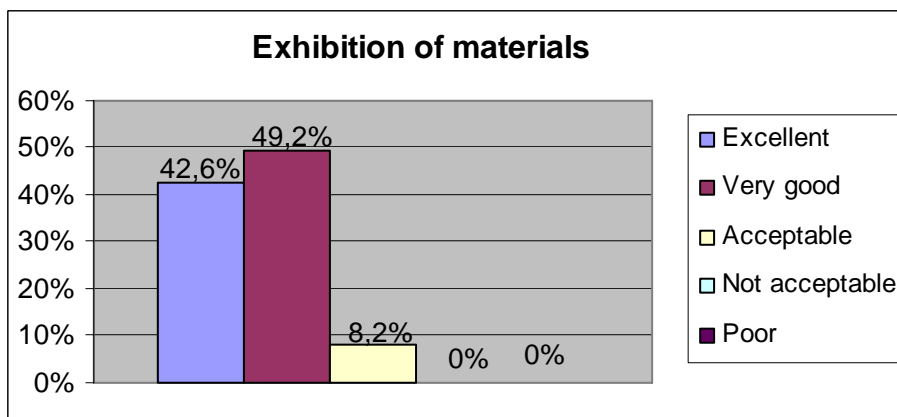
90,2% of the participants show a great satisfaction with the selection of the speakers. 41% of the speakers have received an “Excellent”, 49,2% a “Very good” and 9,8% an “Acceptable”. Nobody has received a “Not acceptable” or “Poor”.

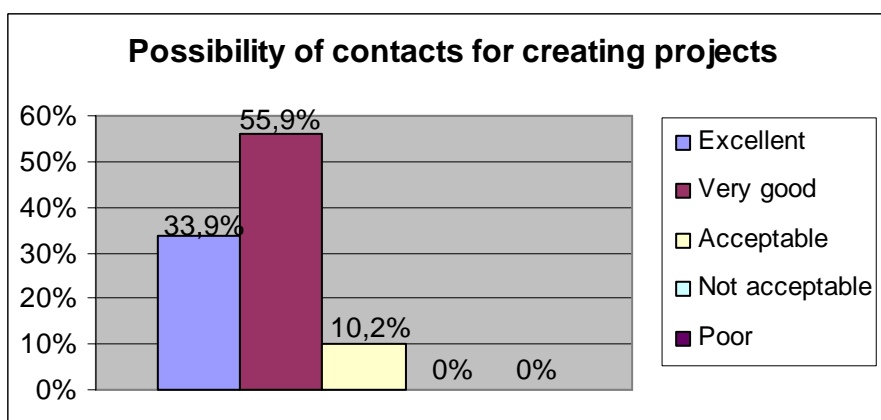
The activities have been held in the Sports and Cultural Complex “La Petxina” in Valencia. 96,7% of the participants have evaluated the location as very positive – 65,6% as “Excellent” and 31,1% as “Very good”. 3,3% think it was “Acceptable”.

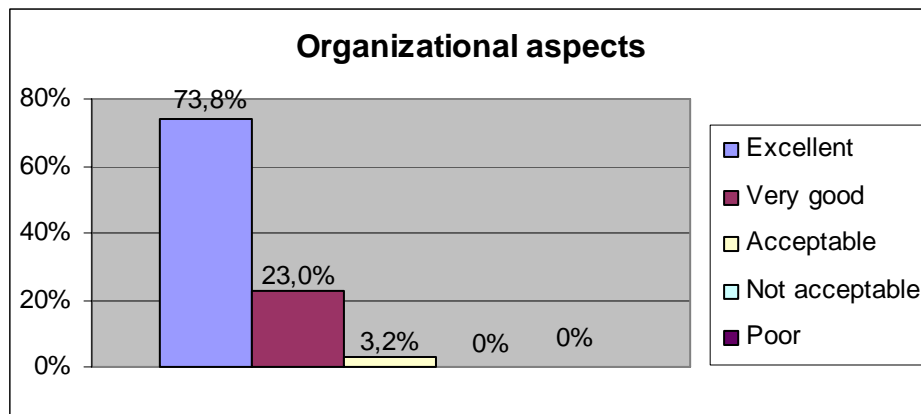
All kind of materials from participants and organizations have been exhibited in the Hall of the Sports and Cultural Complex “La Petxina”. This exhibition has been evaluated positively by 91,8% of the participants. 42,6% has evaluated it as “Excellent”, 49,2% as “Very good” and 8,2% as “Acceptable”.

89,8% of the participants evaluate positively the possibility of creating contacts during the Meeting as well as in the work groups. 33,9% of them think it was “Excellent”, 55,9% say it was “Very good” and 10,2% “Acceptable”.

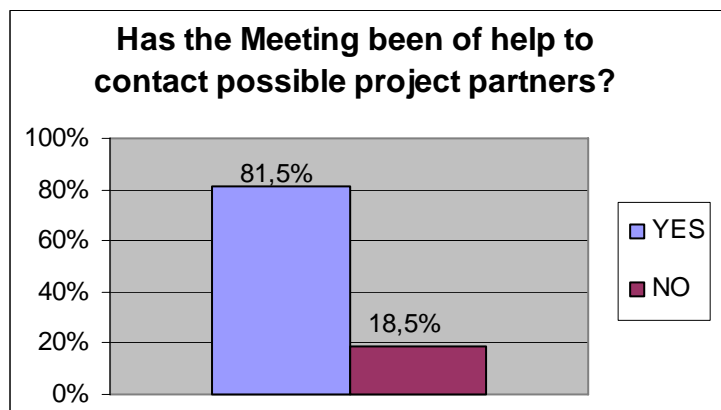

With respect to the aspects related to the organization, 100% of the participants evaluate them positively: 73,8% “Excellent”, 23% “Very good” and 3,2% “Acceptable”.
