We assume that it is extremely important for the project to attract and educate as many people (students, their parents, teachers, all the school workers, local people, etc.) as possible.

Observations/Remarks:
 Our project has been warmly welcomed by the local society and authorities. It was even awarded by the Warsaw Agency of Education. Primary school students do adore this subject. However, we have managed to activate many various groups of interest, such as the nursery school children and their teachers, our canteen workers, the day-room workers, students’ parents and grandparents, and even all our district (with its authorities). We hope (and have to some extent observed) that the project has already initiated a change in the nutrition habits.
